D&S ENGINEERS AND ARCHITECTS

A variety of new leachate treatment methods are currently being developed and explored. This session will take a look at the use of cogeneration for landfill leachate evaporation, cement products for solidification/stabilization of leachate concentrate, and the approach to PFAS treatment in leachate.

Upon successful completion of this course, the attendee will be able to:

- Understand how waste heat from landfill gas can be used to treat leachate in a traditional CoVAP cogeneration application
- Describe LafargeHolcim's method for encapsulating PFAS from leachate concentrate
- Discuss the benefits of using treated leachate as daily cover
- Recall the PFAS compositions of leachate
- Understand the nuanced approach to address potential PFAS treatment requirements
- Identify the abilities and limitations of existing PFAS treatment processes
